

Global Financials – The European Challenge

Can a Global Corporation leverage a single primary transaction General ledger without set of books duplication into a Statutory, Fiscal and management reporting engine that consolidates transparently under European GAAP and US GAAP rules?

Some European countries proscribe a Chart of Accounts for statutory and Fiscal reporting normally necessitating a GCS solution to transfer detailed transactions or balances to satisfy this requirement.

Can another solution be more efficient and twice as effective in terms of rationalising manpower and complexity?
