PA Module Definition

- Core (Project Costing / Billing)
 - Project Classes
 - Capital, Contract, Indirect
- Miscellaneous
 - Project Resource Management
 - Project Collaboration
 - Project Contracts
 - Project Management
 - Project Intelligence
- Grants Accounting







Capital Projects

- Fixed Assets can be created by project accounting
- Projects can be Work in Process
- Asset created can be one Asset and additions are added as work is created.
- Can create individual asset via projects





Cost Accounting

- SFFAS 4
 - The FASAB developed accounting standards
 - Approved by Department of Treasury, Office of Management and Budget and the Government Accounting Office
- Direct Cost
- Indirect Cost





Direct Costing Project

- Direct cost (POET)
- Sources of direct costs
 - OTL
 - PO (commitments and obligations)
 - Inventory
 - Pre-approved expenditures





Indirect Costing

- Indirect Cost (Allocations)
 - GL allocations
 - Project Allocations
 - Source
 - Project
 - Target
 - Project and Task
 - Basis
 - Offset
 - Project / Task
 - Z-tasks and why







Costing Allocations

- Allocations
 - Use of Source and Basis
 - Destination and offset
- Two Federal Examples
 - Activity
 - Direct
 - Indirect collection
 - Operating Results
 - Direct
 - Indirect destinations





Cost Accounting

- SFFAS 4 describes four costing methodologies
 - Standard Costing (standard cost / variances)
 - Job Order (producing a specific missile silo)
 - Process Costing (oil and gas)
 - Activity Based Costing (computer system)





Account Generation

- Federal Attributes
 - Fund Placement (Service type)
 - Cost Center (Expenditure Org)
 - Organization ID (Task owning Org)
 - Object / Sub-object class (Expenditure type)
- Oracle Project Accounting attributes
 - Project / Task / Expenditure types / Organization(s) and DFF's
 - Employee attributes / Service type





Project Budgets

- Revenue Budgeting (more to come later)
 - Approved Revenue Budget
 - Forecast Revenue Budget
- Cost Budgets
 - Approved Cost Budget
 - Forecast Cost Budget
- Baseline, Reporting





Federal Projects' Funds Checking

- Federal Funds Checking
 - Sub-Allotment 461001 level checking
 - Project Cost Budgets Funds Checking
 - Encumbrance accounting availability
 - Enhancement to check the project's Cost Budget
- Order of preference





Project Billing

- Agreements
- Customer tied to the Project or Task (M)
- Revenue Budgets
- Generate Revenue Budgets (Move to GL)
- Generate Draft Invoice
- Approve Invoices
- Interface to AR
- AR Transfers Accounting to GL







Federal Project Billing

- Agreement / auto-create revenue budget
- Billing method at Project or Top Task
- Can assign customers at Top Task, M-patchset
- Agreement Extension for entry of sub-allotment and anticipated revenue entries
- Performance toward the project
- Revenue Extension books actual revenue
- Advances are created by Invoice Events
- Invoice generation (draft)
- Extension of mass approval of draft invoice
- Invoice interfaced and printed in AR







Invoice Creation

- Each project can have invoice grouping
 - Labor Grouping
 - Non Labor Grouping
- Invoice Creation
- Transfer to AR
- Invoice Generation
 - Standard AR view
 - 1080 creation
- Consolidated Billing







Federal Extensions Detail

- Agreement Extension
 - Sub-alloted funds
 - Anticipated Revenue
- Revenue Extension
 - Actual revenue
- Mass Approval Extension
 - Approval of multiple draft invoices in one process
- Consolidate Billing Extension







Future of PA Federal

- R 12.0.4 Current release (Not for Federal)
- R 12.1 Some federalization Planned release in 2008, what is expected?
- R 12.2 More federalization Planned to be released in 2009, what is expected?





Release 12.0.3

- Currently available to commercial clients
- Not yet FSIO Certified (now in progress)
- Will be 1st R-12 version FSIO Certified
- No new "Federal" specific Project functionality
- But Yes, New Functionality exists (end of Presentation)





Release 12.1

- Pre-defined SLA accounting definitions that create budgetary and proprietary accounting entries as appropriate for the transactions that Projects generates accounting.
- Project budgets can be interfaced to the Federal Financials Budget Execution module. Also, actual journal entries (as opposed to budget journal entries) can be generated based on project budgets.
- Prepayment cash receipts entered in Oracle Receivables can be applied and tracked against reimbursable agreements in Projects.
- New funds consumption controls for billing -- billing sequences, expiration date, and funds remaining.
- New data elements can be entered on Agreements -- customer order number, line of accounting, 15 descriptive flexfields, advances required, and billing sequence. Users can manually indicate on the agreement when advances are required, or a client extension is available to define conditions for when cash advances are required.
- Agreement number can be entered on revenue/billing events.







Release 12.2

- Next attempt at FSIO certification.
- Multiple document and accounting lines agreement definition, control, and tracking
- Automated cash advances functionality -advance requests, automatic application to reimbursable agreements, IPAC integration, and billing in excess of cash advances.
- Reimbursable agreement query
- Reimbursable agreement close out







Conclusions

- Oracle Projects is used in Federal environment for costing and reimbursements
- Each implementation is unique, but similar
- Future Federal Project Accounting functionality will be here
