Executive Management Requirements

- Manage organization's budget
- Manage organization's resources
- Manage organization's growth
- Define organization's direction & focus
- Determine most profitable business lines







Executive Management Analytics

- What types of projects are most profitable?
- What types of projects or services consume most of our resources?
- Which department's projects are consistently within budget?
- Which department's projects are consistently over budget?
- What's the average price of resources or services within a given ERP product?
- How do our resource hours break down between employees and contractors?

- Project Level
 - Project Type
 - Project Class Category
 - Project Organization
- Task Level
 - Service Type
 - Work Type
- Transaction Level
 - Expenditure Category
 - Expenditure Type







Project Level Data Elements

- Project Type
 - A template defined for your implementation. The template consists of project attributes such as the project type class (contract, indirect, or capital), the default revenue distribution rule and bill rate schedules, and whether the project burdens costs.
- Project Class Category
 - An implementation—defined category for classifying projects.
- Project Organizations
 - The Organization that owns the project.

Task Level Data Elements

- Service Type
 - An implementation—defined classification of the type of work performed on a task.
- Work Type
 - An implementation—defined classification of work performed.

- Design
- Develop

Transaction Level Data Elements

- Expenditure Category
 - An implementation-defined grouping of expenditure types by type of cost.
- Expenditure Type
 - An implementation—defined classification of cost that you assign to each expenditure item.







Expenditure Categories & Types

- Expenditure Category Labor
 - Expenditure Type Employees
 - Expenditure Type Contractors
- Expenditure Category Expenses
 - Expenditure Type Airfare
 - Expenditure Type Lodging
 - Expenditure Type Ground Transportation
 - Expenditure Type Meals
